Peter E. Raskind has been a consultant to banks and those contemplating investing in banks since January 2009.

Mr. Raskind was Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of National City Corporation, one of the largest banks in the United States, prior to its merger with PNC Financial Services Group on Dec. 31, 2008. He had been Chairman since December 2007 and Chief Executive Officer since July 2007. Raskind had been a Director of the company since January 2007.

Mr. Raskind began his career with National City in 2000 as the Head of the Consumer Finance division. He was named to head the company's Consumer and Small Business Financial Services (Retail Banking) division in 2002. He was appointed Vice Chairman in 2004, and became President in December 2006 with responsibility for Retail Banking, Corporate Banking and Wealth Management.

Prior to National City, Mr. Raskind had a 17-year career with U.S. Bancorp/First Bank System, holding positions in a broad range of disciplines: cash management services, corporate finance, international banking, corporate trust, retail banking, operations and strategic planning.

Mr. Raskind began his career with Harris Bank, where he held positions in corporate finance and cash management services.

He has served as a Director of Visa USA, Visa International and Inovant L.L.C. He has also served on the Board of Directors of the Consumer Bankers Association, and been a member of the Financial Services Roundtable.
