General Job Description:

The Cleveland- Cuyahoga County Port Authority is seeking a skilled **Industrial Maintenance Technician** to perform upkeep tasks such as repairs, improvements, inspections and general housekeeping. You will be responsible for applying fixes to equipment and building systems and ensure facilities are tidy, safe, and functional.

Being reliable, punctual, and motivated with a keen eye for detail is imperative. The ideal candidate will have experience and solid technical knowledge. You must also possess manual dexterity, physical stamina, and be comfortable working from heights and in close proximity to water.

Duties and Responsibilities:

This position will report directly to the Cleveland- Cuyahoga County Port Authority's Director of Facilities and Operations and will also receive direction and instruction from the Port's Millwright.

This position will provide a supportive role to the function of the Port's Millwright and will include general labor including: equipment repair and preventative maintenance, landscaping, plumbing, electrical work, carpentry, trash removal, painting, HVAC work, and other general maintenance duties as assigned. The CCCPA owns and maintains 2 mobile harbor cranes, 2 reach stacker machines, 1 overhead warehouse crane, 1 stationary heavy lift crane, 2 work barges, 2 Snorkel man lifts, 4 trucks/SUVs, and 1 yard spotter. The ideal candidate will possess the ability to learn how these machines function and how to maintain them with the intent of minimizing equipment down time. A strong understanding of mechanical and hydraulic systems is preferred.

Providing a clean, safe, and functional environment for the employees, visitors, and stakeholders at the Cleveland- Cuyahoga County Port Authority is the objective of this position.
